



## Sample Monthly Plan

Our goal is for our students to engage in Jewish learning and experiences over nine months for a total of 60-70 hours. Hebrew tutoring is counted in addition to these hours for students in 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades. This sample plan is only a guide. We understand that schedules are complex and parents will choose what works best for their family. Our family advisor, Erin Faigin, will help families to figure out a plan that works for them.

Our classes, services, and workshops will be virtual unless we are confident that we can safely meet in person. Family field trips will strictly follow public health guidelines and will be outdoors.

Families should feel free to mix and match activities. We can give a student guidance if they wish to do more independent learning.
