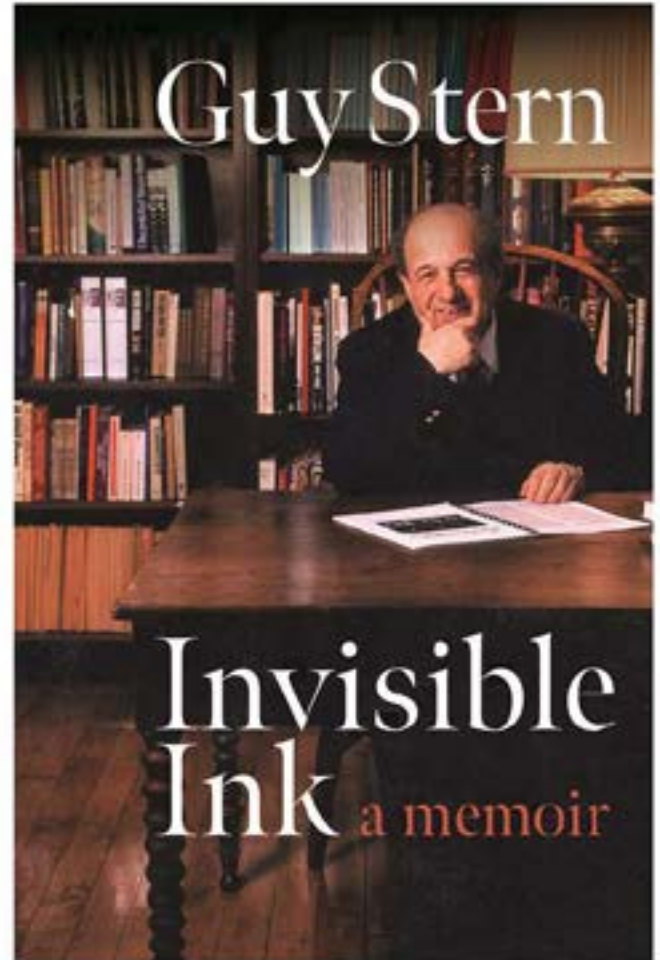

World-renowned Holocaust scholar **Dr. Michael Berenbaum** will interview **Dr. Guy Stern** in an online Zoom webinar about Guy's remarkable life and his new memoir. Born in Germany, Guy was the only one in his family to escape from the Holocaust. He served in a U.S. military intelligence unit and earned a Bronze Star Medal for his work interrogating German prisoners of war. Today, Guy is the HMC's Director of the Harry and Wanda Zekelman International Institute of the Righteous and a Distinguished Professor Emeritus at Wayne State University.

Have you ever wondered, “Who are these very thoughtful people and why are their names listed in the Scribe?”

In every issue of the *Scribe*, we recognize individuals who go above and beyond their dues commitment for our Temple’s fiscal year. We appreciate their commitment and generosity. We often get questions about the different categories, so we thought we would take a moment to describe what each one specifically means.

First, it is necessary to know that dues rates vary. At different life stages and situations, we ask different commitments from our members. That being said, we never want finances to be an obstacle to membership and we are always willing to discuss individual circumstances privately.

TZEDAKAH CIRCLE

Tzedakah Circle participants are those who give an additional \$500 on top of their specific dues rate, regardless of which rate that is.

VATIKIM

Vatik means “enduring, trusty, or strong.” *Vatikim* is also sometimes interpreted as “the most spiritually advanced”. This level of participation is for our congregants who are at the senior dues base rate and have chosen to also give above that amount.

CHAI

Chai participants have a dues rate of \$3,445.

DOUBLE CHAI

Double Chai participants have a dues rate of \$4,345.
