MEAH HEBREW AND RELIGION SCHOOL (MEAH) FEES POLICY

TUITION FEES

Tuition fees are charged for all students attending Meah, with separate rates for NSTE members and non-members.

There are reduced rates for the second and other children of parents/guardians, if all are attending Meah at the same time.

Fees can be paid annually or each term. If required, arrangements may be made for regular monthly payments either by credit card or direct debit.

Tuition fees for each term must be paid or a credit card debit arrangement entered into prior to the start of each term. If fees are not paid by the end of the second week of term, the student will not be permitted to attend Meah classes, unless a special arrangement has been made through agreement with the Temple Administrator or Director of Education (Meah).

If there are exceptional circumstances NSTE will consider a request for reduced tuition fees. Such requests should be submitted through the Director of Education (Meah).

STUDENT WITHDRAWAL AND TUITION FEE REFUNDS

Advice of intention to withdraw a student from Meah needs to be received by the Director of Education (Meah) at least one week prior to the commencement of term. Late notice of withdrawal will result in a full term's fees being payable.

Tuition fees paid in advance will only be refunded if a student withdraws before the start of term, except for Term 1 (or the first term of attendance by a student) for which notice of withdrawal must be received before the start of the third week of term.

Apart from as mentioned above, tuition fees will only be refunded after the commencement of the term, if there are exceptional circumstances.
