## High Holy Days with Beth Shalom in 2021 /5782

We welcome all of you to join us, as together we gather at Beth Shalom and observe these special High Holy Days. These holidays are a time of celebration and reflection, and this year will be unique as we reflect on an eventful year and blend our traditional services with new offerings to accommodate the various needs of our diverse synagogue community.

### NEW this year -

- **Rosh Hashanah Family Service**, September 6, 10:30 am

This is a Rosh Hashanah Service in our usual Family Shabbat Service style, with prayers, Shofar blowing, and Torah story. In addition to our (moderately short) service, we will also have some games and activities for children in our backyard.

- **Yom Kippur Morning Service September 16 9:30 will be directly followed by Yizkor**

- **Yom Kippur Family Service**, September 16, 5 pm

We conclude Yom Kippur together, as we close the High Holidays with a special Service (in our usual Family Shabbat Service style). A short service will be followed by an activity for children in our Social Hall, while in parallel parents and adults stay in our sanctuary for a reflection and conversation time with our Rabbi.

Havdalah ceremony will follow, and a final Shofar blowing.

Then – let's Break the Fast together, plans will be announced

- **Tickets: Online "E" tickets** will be made available to renewed members soon. Guests will be required to register for tickets, which will include a request for a donation in lieu of charging a fee. The ticketing system will include a way for everyone to make a donation, which we would greatly appreciate.

\*The Family Service events will be replacing our Children's morning services programming. **\*We will offer Babysitting on Holiday mornings for pre-registered children under age 5.**
