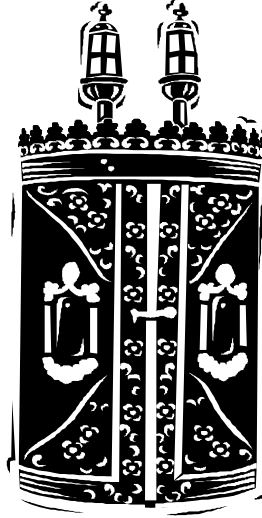

Tuition – 2019-2020

The Congregation Beth Shalom Religious School program serves children in Pre-kindergarten through 10th grade. To keep children's grades in line with their Bar or Bat Mitzvah year, a child must be six years old by September 1 to enter First Grade. Depending on enrollment, Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten may be combined. To prevent a large range of ages in a potentially combined class, a child must be five years old by September 1 to enter Kindergarten, and four years old by September 1 to enter Pre-Kindergarten.

Families must be members in good standing of Congregation Beth Shalom to register for school.

Student and Parents' Code of Rights and Responsibilities

In an effort to maintain the best possible learning environment at Congregation Beth Shalom Religious School, we recognize the following individual rights and responsibilities:

- 1) **The right to feel safe and the responsibility to make sure others feel safe.**
- 2) **The right to be respected as an individual and the responsibility to respect others.**
- 3) **The right to use Congregation Beth Shalom and its grounds and the responsibility to protect them.**

To participate in the Congregation Beth Shalom Religious School, parents and students must affirm the following:

- 1) **I am responsible for making this a safe environment. Some of the ways I can help to create a safe environment are:**
 - a) I will keep my hands, my feet and objects to myself
 - b) I will walk safely when inside a Congregation Beth Shalom building
 - c) I will only bring safe objects to Congregation Beth Shalom
 - d) I will be where I am expected to be
 - e) I will keep Congregation Beth Shalom a drug, alcohol and tobacco free place
- 2) **I am responsible for making sure people respect each other. Some of the ways I can help to create a respectful environment are:**
 - a) I will speak kindly to others and will not say hurtful things
 - b) I will listen when others are speaking and will expect others to listen to me
 - c) I will wait my turn to speak and will not interrupt others
 - d) I will do my best to make sure that nobody feels left out
 - e) I will respect responsible requests of my teachers and other adults
 - f) I will support Congregation Beth Shalom school activities and will not disrupt them
 - g) I will treat the belongings of others with respect
 - h) All of my interactions with others will be respectful
- 3) **I am responsible for taking care of the Congregation Beth Shalom buildings and everything in and around it. Some of the ways I can take care of Congregation Beth Shalom are:**
 - a) I will leave the bathrooms clean and neat
 - b) I will clean up my work area and put away all materials
 - c) I will keep books, walls and furniture free from writing and other forms of damage
 - d) I will leave chewing gum at home
 - e) I will leave my cell phone turned off and in my pocket
 - f) All of my behaviors will reflect appropriate respect for Congregation Beth Shalom

Students who adhere to the Code of Rights and Responsibilities will enjoy the privilege of being a welcome part of the Congregation Beth Shalom community.

Dress Code

Students who are dressed appropriately for Religious School are wearing neat and clean clothing and shoes. Specific items that are not appropriate include:

- 1) Torn, worn or dirty clothing or shoes
- 2) Halter tops, crop tops or muscle shirts
- 3) Shorts that are too short or too baggy
- 4) Clothing with inappropriate slogans or pictures relating to gangs, drugs, alcohol, obscenities, sex, violence or tobacco

Attendance Policies

- 1) Students should arrive on time and remain until dismissed
- 2) Tzedakah (charity) is encouraged. Children are asked to bring at least 2 quarters each Sunday.
- 3) Students may bring a guest to class occasionally to share our heritage with friends. Remember that you must notify the School Director beforehand. Guests are expected to behave and dress appropriately.
- 4) Children are dismissed by their teachers. Prior arrangements must be made for early dismissal. When leaving early, children must be signed out in the Religious School office. Leaving the Religious School campus without permission is prohibited.
- 5) If children miss two or more consecutive classes, the Religious School Director must be notified.
