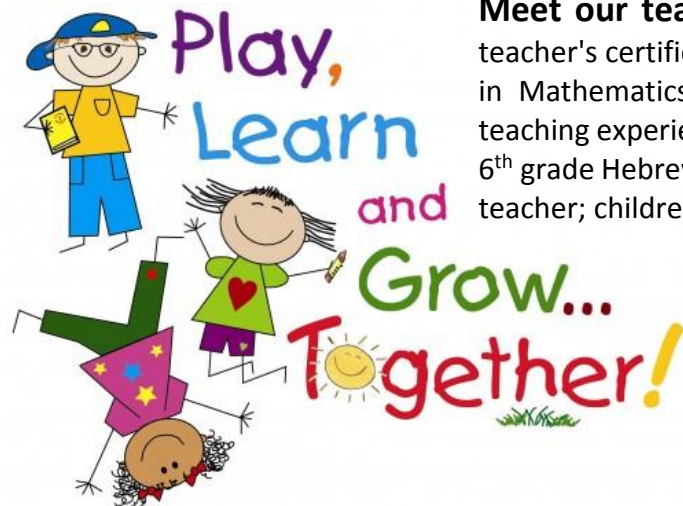

- 9 meetings throughout the year, each meeting is 2 hours long, Sunday mornings, once a month
- 2-3 staff people for a class (1 teacher + 1 or 2 aides, depending on class size)

- Each meeting will focus on a Jewish holiday (according to the calendar) and Shabbat / Havdalah
