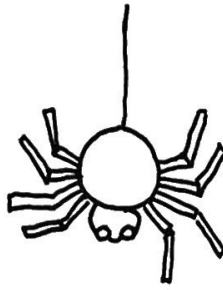




Sammy listens to all the birds sing,

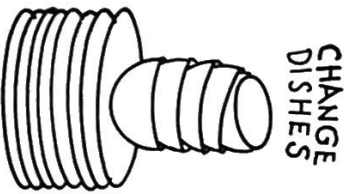
Preparing for seder can be fun.

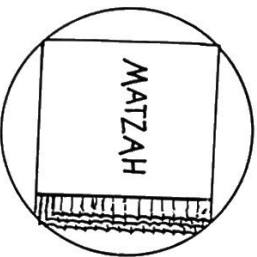
Game instructions (for two players):

Cut out game cards and give each player one set. Use buttons as markers. The youngest goes first. Each player flips a coin and moves ahead one space for heads, two spaces for tails. When a player lands on a picture square, he or she collects the corresponding picture card. Continue around the board until one player has collected all eight cards. You will probably have to go around the board more than once.

Note: You may want to copy or paste the cards onto heavier paper and cover with plastic adhesive. You can also play matching and memory games with these cards.



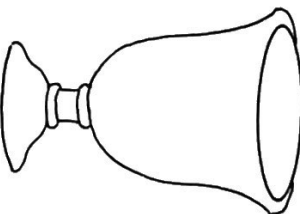

SPIDER WEB MATZAH

Ingredients:

1/2 c. chocolate chips
1 teaspoon margarine
1 matzah

Instructions:
