Congregant reads before Aliyah:

Bar'khu et Adonai ha-m'vorach.

Bless Adonai, the blessed One.

Congregation responds:

Barukh Adonai ha-m'vorach l'olam va'ed.

בָּרוּךְ אֲדֹנָי הַמְּבֹרָךְ לְעוֹלָם וָעֶד:

Blessed is Adonai, the blessed One for all eternity.

Congregant repeats above response, then continues:

Barukh atah Adonai,
Eloheinu melekh ha'olam,
asheir bakhar banu mikol ha'amim,
v'natan lanu et torato.
Barukh atah Adonai,
notein ha-Torah.

Congregant reads after Aliyah:

Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu melekh
ha'olam, asheir natan lanu torat emet,
v'hayei olam nata b'tokheinu. Barukh
atah Adonai, notein ha-torah.
