The annual subscription year runs from May 1st to April 30th. In the year of joining members' subscriptions are pro-rated to the next April 30th in whole months. For instance, for a partnership, aged 36 and over, joining on February 1st, the subscription for the first year is: £1280 x 3 (months) / 12 = £320.00. For a single person in the same age range joining on November 15th, it is £780 x 6 / 12 = £390.00. Subscriptions may be paid annually or quarterly as desired, although it should be noted that Annual Direct Debits are easier for the office to manage. Subscriptions should be paid by Direct Debit, using the enclosed form.

A Gift Aid Form is enclosed which enables the Synagogue to claim 25 pence from the Inland Revenue for every £1.00 you contribute in membership fees and donations. Please complete it providing that the Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax you pay is at least equal to the amount of basic rate tax that Westminster Synagogue and any other charities you donate to will reclaim on your gift. You must also have a UK address.

For members resident in the USA for tax purposes, a similar scheme is available, provided by CAFAmerica. Please ask the Synagogue office for details and a form.

In exceptional cases where the standard subscriptions rates are beyond their means, members are asked to discuss the matter in confidence with either the Membership Secretary or Rabbi Benji Stanley. Those able to pay more than the standard rates are earnestly requested to do so.
