Shemot (Exodus) 20:19-21

(20) With Me, therefore, you shall not make any gods of silver, nor shall you make for yourselves any gods of gold.

(21) Make for Me an altar of earth and sacrifice on it your burnt offerings and your sacrifices of well-being, your sheep and your oxen; in every place where I cause My name to be mentioned I will come to you and bless you.

- What do you think is the relationship between verse 19 and 20? What in verse 19 provides rationale for why we shouldn't make idols?
- What's the possible relationship between verse 21 and the two verses beforehand? What in the two previous verses suggest why God should be served this way and not other ways?
- What qualities of interaction with Torah and the Divine come across in these verses? How can we recreate them? How do we recreate them?
