Registration is required BY AUGUST 15 if you plan on attending in person OR if you would like to [send Zoom links to a guest](#). If you prefer paper copies of the schedule and/or the pass reservation forms, please call the Main Office. Please note the following:

- **Zoom Options Available to Everyone!** All Sanctuary services, and the 9:00 a.m. family services, will also be broadcast on Zoom. Zoom links will be sent to all temple members in advance of the services. Registration is NOT required for temple members to receive Zoom links this year. Zoom access will be available to those who are not temple members, but will require [prior registration](#).
- **Proof of Vaccination Required for 12+:** Individuals ages 12 and older may only attend in the sanctuary if they have been vaccinated regardless of PCR status. **Submitted proof of vaccination via the [online form](#) OR mailed to the office will be required in order to receive passes to the individual services for which you RSVP.**
- **Family Seating Area:** Family members under the age of 12 who are not eligible for vaccinations, but who have shared proof (via upload or bringing on the day of the service) of a negative PCR test (not before September 3 for Rosh Hashanah) may join their vaccinated families in a specifically designated “family seating area” in the Sanctuary.
- **PCR Testing Required for Those Unvaccinated, Ages 2 and above:** For those who are 2 and above, but who are unvaccinated, proof of a negative PCR test conducted (no earlier than September 3 for Rosh Hashanah and no earlier than September 12 for Yom Kippur) is required for all in person attendance at holiday programming. Please contact the temple office if you have questions about where to get a PCR test. **Reminder: attendees age 12 and older who have not submitted proof of vaccination will not be permitted to enter the Sanctuary, regardless of PCR status.**
- **Registration and Permitted Guests:** In order to manage in-person capacity, individuals and families will need to register for each individual service they want to attend in person in advance, whether inside or outside. The only guests that will be permitted this year will be: parents, grown children, grandchildren, and siblings of our members. Guest passes will not be issued to others.
- **Indoor Ventilation:** Please note that MERV-13 air filters have been installed throughout our building. We will also be leaving as many doors and windows (in the sanctuary and throughout the building) open as possible so as to maximize cross-ventilation.
- **Outdoor Tent:** There will be an outdoor tent on our premises (featuring the Zoom broadcast from the Sanctuary). Note that proof of vaccination will not be required for the outdoor tent; however, in lieu of proof of vaccination for unvaccinated individuals, proof of a negative PCR is required. All attendees in the outdoor tent must wear a mask and passes will be required for the outside tent space.

- **Masking During All Worship:** Given the central role that music plays in our worship experience, and the scientific data around singing, we require that all attendees (at services both inside and outside) be masked during worship. **Please note:** attendees both inside and outside, over the age of 2, who refuse to wear a mask during worship will be politely asked to leave our campus.
- **Youth and Teen Programming:** Concurrent youth and teen programming will take place both on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur mornings on the second floor of our building and will utilize our outdoor spaces as well. Safety protocols for those programs will be shared with families later in the summer.

COVID PROTOCOLS

Indoor Services (Sanctuary or Youth/Teen Programming)

- Masks must be worn at all times by everyone ages 2+
- Ages 12+ must submit proof of vaccination
- Unvaccinated individuals 12+ may join us in our outside tent space only

Outdoor Services and Programming (Outdoor Tent Broadcast, Sunrise Service, Shofar Service, Havdalah)

- Masks must be worn at all times by everyone ages 2+
- Ages 2+ must submit proof of vaccination OR submit/bring proof of a negative PCR test

Who Can Come as A Guest?

- Your parents, grown children, grandchildren, or siblings
- Guests must be registered in advance and are subject to the protocols above regarding masks, vaccination and/or PCR testing
