Dear Members and Friends,

During the period known as "the three weeks", which includes the first few days of the Month of Av, we are all expected to reflect and focus on the sadness generated by tragedies that occurred throughout Jewish history. Specific guidelines and restrictions are followed during this particular time – such as avoiding live music, no haircuts, and no weddings – as we collectively recall these sad events. However, mourning is not observed on Shabbat. This is due to the principle of Oneg Shabbat, which means that we need to put an emphasis on joy

and celebration. Shabbat serves as a time of spiritual rejuvenation, and mourning rituals are therefore incompatible with the essence of Shabbat. The Talmud likens the Messianic redemption to Shabbat, making it particularly fitting to focus on the exhilaration of redemption – especially during Shabbat within these three weeks that commemorate the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem. My fervent prayer is that we all see the rebuilding of our Temple, במהרה בימינו אמן.
