

COVID Update
November 1, 2021

To our Temple Beth Tikvah Kehillah

Based on the increase in vaccinated adults and the announcement of vaccine availability for children ages 5-12, the TBT COVID Task Force has recommended the following modifications to our active protocols concerning Food Service.

Beginning December 1, **Indoor FOOD events will resume** under the following provisions:

- All guests must remain masked except while eating and drinking, and should remain at the table while unmasked
- When moving around, guests are asked to wear their masks
- Based upon room capacity, there will be a limit on the number of guests dining. Please speak with the office staff when planning any indoor food event

Use of the Social Hall for B. Mitzvah Shabbat Kiddush receptions is encouraged, however due to the need to keep the walls to the sanctuary down, all tables must be set and decorated prior to 5:00 pm on Friday afternoon.

Food serve may include the following:

- Boxed lunches
- Buffet, with servers
- Wait Staff served platters

Protocols remaining in effect:

As we enter the winter months, out of an abundance of caution, the mask requirement for all persons over the age of 3 years while inside the TBT facility will be extended. Outdoor mask wearing is optional to meet personal comfort.

Until such time when all children are able to be vaccinated we are asking non-vaccinated individuals to refrain from unmasking or attending indoor food events.

**Should there be another viral surge, we reserve the right to rescind indoor food activities until such time deemed safe*
