To our Temple Beth Tikvah Kehillah

Due to the rapid increase in COVID cases in our area and based upon the recommendations of the GA Department of Health and the District Health Director at an emergency meeting on 12/24/21 the following modifications to the TBT COVID policy will be in effect through January 10, 2022.

- 1) The TBT Mask requirement will remain in effect. All persons over the age of 4 years must be masked while inside the synagogue facility. Mask wearing outdoors is strongly encouraged when gathering as a community.
- 2) We strongly encourage our members to get vaccinated and boosted. However, if someone's personal choice is not to do so, then we kindly request that for the next two weeks they refrain from coming into the synagogue building. If one needs access to the facility, please contact the office at 770-642-0434.
- 3) During this highly contagious period, we are suspending the serving of food and beverage in the TBT facility. We will reassess the situation in mid-January.
- 4) In-person religious school classes will resume after January 10, 2022.

Please be in contact with the school directors with any questions relating to your child's specific school program.
