### RABBI DR. GIDEON M. GOLDENHOLZ



The 15th day of the month of Shvat is the new year for trees. This year it is celebrated on January 25, 2024.

Tu BiShvat became the date for calculating the beginning of the agricultural cycle for the purpose of biblical tithes, and also marks the beginning of the season in which the earliest-blooming trees in Israel (namely the almond

trees) begin to bloom, signifying a new fruit-bearing cycle.

In the Middle Ages the custom developed to celebrate Tu BiShvat with a feast of fruits, and in the 16th century the Kabbalist Rabbi Yitzchak Luria and his students instituted a Tu BiShvat Seder (in the image of the Pesach Seder) in which the fruits and trees of the Land of Israel were given symbolic meaning . These customs have been renewed in modern Israel, and are widely celebrated by religious and secular alike, due to a deep connection to the land in Israeli society. This day is also celebrated as an ecological awareness day, and trees are often planted in festive ceremonies.

The Torah in Genesis Chapter 2 describes humans and their place in the Garden of Eden. The first person is set in the Garden "to work it and take care of it." The two Hebrew verbs used here are significant. The first – le'ovdah – literally means "to serve it." The human being is thus both master and servant of nature. The second – leshomrah – means "to guard it." This is the verb used in later biblical legislation to describe the responsibilities of a guardian of property that belongs to someone else. This guardian must exercise vigilance while protecting and is personally liable for losses that occur through negligence. This is perhaps the best short definition of humanity's responsibility for nature as the Bible conceives it.

We do not own nature – "The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof." (Tehillim 24:1) We are its stewards on behalf of God, who created and owns everything. As guardians of the earth, we are duty-bound to respect its integrity.

# KASSELMAN SCHOOL NEWS Lina Jezo, ECE Director



It is hard to believe that we are halfway through the year! Where has the time gone? We are thrilled to have more families join our Sinai family as we start the new year! We are grateful to all the families that attended the Temple Hanukkah dinner and our ECE Hanukkah performance! The gathering of all our ECE families was wonderful.

With great pleasure, we announce that registration for Summer Camp 2024 will

open this month! We will also offer an early bird special for the 2024-2025 academic year registration and summer camp enrollment! Enrollment fills up quickly, so be on the lookout for our email and ClassDojo post!

Every Friday during the academic year, we will still hold our ECE Tot Shabbat in our sanctuary. Our ECE families are always welcome to join us for an enjoyable interactive Shabbat with all of our students, which includes live music performed by Marcelo - a great pianist and guitarist. Every week, kids put a lot of effort into earning a mitzvah, and on Shabbat, they are honored with an award ceremony. These days, we provide after-school enrichment programs in soccer, swimming, cooking, Spanish, S.T.E.M., ballet, and Israeli dance in addition to Judaica, and physical education.

I'd like to give you a glimpse into my approach to early child-hood education as well as a day in the life of your preschooler at Sinai. Numerous studies have demonstrated that kids who receive early childhood education perform better in high school and college and are much better equipped for elementary school. They also have considerably superior social abilities. I want each one of you to know that your kids are developing and learning while they are here, even during playtime. Our curriculum aims to bring out the best in each of our pupils. Our preschool days are packed with planned activities. It includes morning greetings (including a signin activity), "work time," small, and large group activities, message boards, snacks, lunch, clean-up, outdoor, and recall times. We also guarantee to incorporate Judaica studies through Shabbat, holidays, and daily prayers.

We offer a comprehensive weekly curriculum that includes skills and objectives, encourage family involvement in school events, hold parent conferences to discuss each child's development and exchange ideas for bringing classroom learning into their homes. Teachers report that as a result, parents are more aware of their children's growth and learning. Our main objective is to provide a healthy, safe learning environment that fosters growth. We anticipate that your youngster will: express their feelings and interests; feel comfortable and independent in achieving their objectives; have a good attitude toward the joy of learning and be driven to study. Do not hesitate to ask us questions concerning your child's learning and activities daily. Knowing about your child's home life will help us support him or her more effectively. By collaborating, we can help your child be on the right path to a happy, healthy childhood filled with exploration and discovery.

Dear Congregants,

Enclosed please find the slate of candidates who have been nominated to serve as officers or members of the Board of Governors of Temple Sinai by the Nominating Committee.

The Annual Meeting will be held on Sunday, January 28, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. in the Temple Sanctuary. A Zoom link will be available for those who are unable to attend in-person and will be sent a few days prior.

As stated in Article 7.8 of the Bylaws of Temple Sinai, all Regular and Associate members in good standing of the Congregation shall have the right of voice and vote at all Annual and Special Meetings of the Congregation. Regular and Associate members may only vote in person (or virtually if a virtual or hybrid meeting) and no absentee or proxy voting shall be allowed. Honorary members in good standing of the Congregation shall have the right of voice but without the right to vote on any matters at all Annual and Special Meetings of the Congregation.

Additionally, as stated in Article 16.10 of the Bylaws, members of the Congregation may become candidates for any office and may be nominated for such office by petition. Each petition must be signed by at least fifteen members of the Congregation in good standing and must be submitted to the President of the Congregation and the Executive Director at least seven days prior to the Annual Meeting.


