Message from Rabbi Gelber

December 15, 2023/3 Tevet 5784 Dear Friends,

In eight days of Hanukkah, I lit candles several times a day, sang, danced, and taught about different of Hanukkah, aspects highlighting the power we have to push light into the darkness. Most special was the opportunity to lead Torah with a Twist: Hanukkah Edition where we began with the invitation to put your body in a shape that represents you at fullest light. Below you'll find photos and statements illuminating some of our participants' light filled selves.

We know we are not always at full light. This is where the shamash, the candle designed to lift up our

individual light, serves as an important image for Hanukkah and for always. Especially as we clean the wax off of our Hanukkah menorahs and return them to our shelves and breakfronts, we must commit to live life as a shamash and notice the shamashim in our lives. Let us enter the Shabbat with commitment to notice our own light and the light of those in our orbit. May we nourish even our


