Please only bring pieces of chametz wrapped in paper bags or napkins. Aluminum foil/plastic wrapping/rubber will NOT be allowed in the fire. Larger chametz items should be disposed of in another manner.

IF BURNING CHAMETZ AT HOME, FOLLOW THESE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

• Supervise children closely at all times! Children should not stand too close to the fire. • While the fire is burning, never add flammable materials to cause the fire to flare up, such as gasoline or lighter fluid.

• When the Chametz finishes burning, don't put the remnants of the fire into the trash. • Be aware of wind conditions, mulch and other flammable landscaping materials.

• If possible, create a buddy system when an older child is placed with a younger child.
