# A MESSAGE FROM RABBI ALON

## DRIVING AWAY DARKNESS

I remember a testimony of an American who witnessed a suicide bombing in a Jerusalem restaurant. In the rest of the world, he said, the place would have been closed for months. But in Israel, after the medical team did their part, another crew came to wash the blood off and clean the area as others replaced the windows that had shattered in the blast, and within hours the restaurant was back in business.

But the October 7 attack is different. Not only because of its magnitude but mainly by its lingering effect. The hostages that are still being held by the murderers, the ongoing fight with Hamas that keeps claiming the lives of IDF soldiers, and our frustration with the shift in public opinion away from Israel makes it very hard to move on.

Abraham Isaac Kook, the first Ashkenazi Chief Rabbi of British Mandatory Palestine (appointed in 1921) wrote, “When the spirit shines, even foggy skies make pleasant light.” I never found this maxim to be more helpful than now. For almost two months, our skies have been foggy, but what gives us the ability to function and the stamina to keep fighting are the occasions in which our spirit shines.

I first felt it hours after I learned of the massacre. We had a Bar Mitzvah in the afternoon of October 7. I didn’t really want to go to the Temple. All I wanted to do was to switch between the Israeli media channels and glean more information. But at 3:00pm I put on my suit and tie and went to TBA. And here is the amazing thing: from the second Ben started the Service, singing *hinei ma tov uma naim*, how good it is to be together, until we all concluded singing *siman tov umazal tov* I didn’t think about the

situation in Israel even once. As Ben’s spirit shone, igniting our own souls, the thick clouds parted and made space for the light to shine.

Sure enough, as the event was over, I went back to the news and all the light disappeared. But in retrospect, I noticed that each time I was involved in a spiritual or Jewish occasion (Shabbat Services, Torah study, or lifecycle events), the light came back. It was not simply a mental distraction from the gloomy reality; it was the power of the spirit that prevailed over hopelessness.

One of the most popular Hanukkah songs in Israel begins with the following stanza:

*We came to drive away the darkness  
in our hands is light and fire.  
Everyone’s a small light,  
and all of us are a strong light.*

Our current story will end up like the Hanukkah one with the victory of the Jews over their enemy. But until that happens, we must cling to every opportunity that makes our spirit shine and drive away the darkness.

# MEN'S CLUB HAPPENINGS



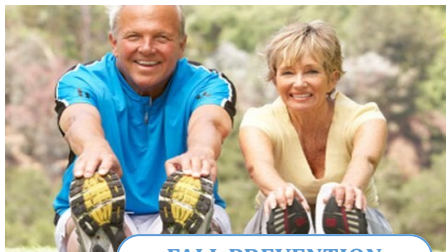

## *How You Can Give to Temple Beth Am*

### LET TEMPLE BETH AM BE PART OF YOUR RETIREMENT STRATEGY AND TAX SAVINGS

Once you reach age 72 (73 if you reached 72 after December 31, 2022), you are required to take annual Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) from your retirement accounts. The IRA Charitable Rollover Law allows individuals 70½ or older to give up to \$100,000 directly from their IRA to qualified charities each year without paying federal income tax on the distribution.

**If you wish to make a gift to benefit Temple Beth Am, talk to your financial advisor about making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) before December 31.**

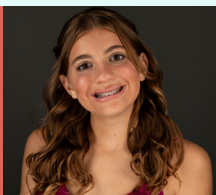

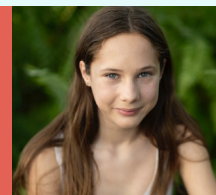

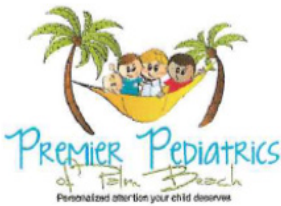
