SEEING THE FOREST FOR THE TREES

At times we are rightly warned that paying too much attention to details may result in losing the ability to see the forest for the trees. I believe that it goes the other way around as well: When focusing mainly on the forest, especially when it is dark and scary, we lose our appreciation of the beauty and vitality of the trees. This is especially true when our image of the forest, the "big picture" of our world, is drawn by the media that favors scenes of conflicts and crises.

In a recent article in *The New York* Times, David Brooks made the point that one of the reasons we are often pessimistic and despondent is that "[we at the media] spend 90 percent of our coverage on the 10 percent of our lives influenced by politics and 10 percent of our coverage on the 90 percent of our lives influenced by relationship, community, and the places we live in." In addition to Brooks' astute observation, I also noticed that a specific matter can evoke in us the opposite reaction when looked at through the lenses of politics versus the lenses of relationships and community.

Last weekend Gali and I attended St. Peter Catholic Church to participate in a celebration in honor of Fr. Don Finney's 25th anniversary as a priest. As I was admiring the social hall that was beautifully transformed and tastefully decorated and taking in the warm and uplifting atmosphere, I realized that some issues that occupied my mind, like the secularization of our society, antisemitism, and immigration felt completely different that night.

Listening to the tribute that masterfully walked a thin line between a roast and a genuine show of respect and love, it was clear that even if the "big picture" indicates a decline in the number of houses of worship in general, the story of many particular communities is just the opposite. For many people, God and faith are still central elements of their lives and many houses of worship, like St. Peter across the road from our Temple, still thrive and engage a diverse group of members.

The "big picture" treats immigration as an explosive political and partisan issue. At the celebration, a group of Hispanic members gave a heartwarming speech in English and Spanish thanking Fr. Don for building the Hispanic Ministry at St. Peter that serves 300 members. At that moment, no one cared about politics—only about faith, gratitude, and the virtue of the community. Later on, Fr. Don told the crowd

that when he took Spanish in high school in South Dakota he never expected to use it, as there was no Spanish-speaking person in sight, yet God had other plans for that skill in his life.

The "big picture" provides us with the data showing a significant increase in anti-Jewish activities. It is true, and keeps many of us up at night. But that night at the church, all we felt was an outpouring of love for the big sister religion, Judaism. Gali and I were seated with Fr. Don and his family, and were thanked publicly for attending the event. I felt that the same divine hand that made the nuns notice the six-yearold Don and assigned him different tasks and responsibilities that led to him becoming a priest, and the hand that made him love Spanish and inspired him to open his heart and church to the Hispanic community, also developed his interest in history which culminated in a Masters degree in Holocaust studies and his becoming a true friend and supporter of the Jewish community.

It is imperative to take a step back so we can see and understand the "big picture". But we should never forget to immerse ourselves in the small details to better appreciate the complexity and the goodness around us.

AN UPDATE ON SECURITY

Temple Beth Am has taken the position that given today's world, our goal is to take an active leadership and responsibility role in the safety of our staff, students, congregants, and visitors to our campus through cyber, physical, as well as training security measures. We have fully implemented our cyber security upgrades.

Our ASR (Active Shooter Response System) is now operational. The various buttons and strobes/sirens are in place and clearly visible throughout the interior and exterior of the building. This system will significantly reduce First Responder response time. TBA staff, Board, and leadership have been trained on the use of these devices and appropriate protocols for its use are in place. There will be announcements for additional ASR training sessions that will be held before the High Holy Days and throughout the year for those who are interested in attending.

TBA is hosting an <u>A</u>lert <u>L</u>ockdown <u>I</u>nform <u>C</u>ounter <u>E</u>vacuate (ALICE) training. The ALICE training structure has evolved over a 20-year period and will require us to minimize activity in the building Aug 6-7, 2019. ALICE training has been implemented in over 5,500 schools and houses of worship, 3,700 businesses/government facilities, and 4,000 law enforcement locations in all 50 states totaling over 1 million participants.

We will be hosting this 2-day instruction certification program that will train 25+ people, primarily from Palm Beach County law enforcement, fire departments, churches, synagogues, school systems, etc. Participants will receive certification to teach their respective organizations the ALICE system (TBA will receive a number of "no cost" seats for hosting). The TBA staff who become certified will hold ALICE training sessions for the rest of TBA staff as well as congregants who wish to receive this training. Overall this will help optimize TBA's awareness, preparedness, and responsiveness in the event of an incident.

During this summer, under an FPL lighting program, our exterior pole lighting will be replaced with LED lighting and remain on from dusk to dawn.

NOTICE: On occasion we have cars parked in our parking lot when there are no TBA events scheduled. For enhanced security our property is clearly marked as private property and no trespassing. We are in the process of finalizing our policy on this matter. If you ever have reason to park your car in our lot when there are NO TBA events please notify the office.

Happy 6th Birthday to 100 Women Who Care!

In August 2013, 23 women gathered in the (old) Temple Beth Am social hall for the first meeting of a grass-roots organization. Our goal: to learn about and support local not-for-profit charities. Fast forward to 2019. The Jupiter/ Tequesta chapter of **100 Women Who Care** now has over 100 members and, in August, we will celebrate the beginning of our 6th year.

In the past 5 years, we have raised nearly \$200,000 for Palm Beach County charities. The money is raised through \$100 donations from each of our members plus a generous matching grant from the Schulze Foundation. Every three months, members meet for one hour to listen to three compelling talks from representatives of local charities. Then, when all our questions have been answered, we vote on which organization will receive our \$10,000-\$15,000 gift.

100 Women Who Care always welcomes new members. The requirements for membership are an open heart and the ability to donate \$400/year to local charities. We meet quarterly at Temple Beth Am, but meeting attendance is not mandatory. The group is a great way to connect with other like-hearted women, share a few laughs and a glass of vino, and make a real difference in our community.




