Happy New Year! Below and attached is the schedule of Temple Israel religious services for the High Holidays. A few introductory notes:

- **Zoom:**
 - Most indoor services will be available over Zoom.
 - All children’s services will be Zoom only. Please check the temple website, www.tisharon.org for special pre-recorded links for children’s stories, music and movement.
 - Zoom Meeting IDs and Passcodes for each service are outlined in this schedule.

- **Limited In-Person Services:**
 - Certain indoor services, on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur will allow up to 15 individuals to attend in person. Outdoor Minha services allow up to 40 people to attend in person. Due to the very limited number of openings available, we cannot guarantee that all requests will be honored. We will make every effort to offer these limited seats to as many congregants as possible.
 - As is the case with our current outdoor services, in-person attendance requires registration and adherence to the safety guidelines established by our Medical Advisory Committee.

For those who wish to limit the use of technology, we have been working with Zoom to enable streams to last the full length of each holiday. To leave your stream open, set your computer not to sleep and make sure that your screen saver is turned off. Then go to www.zoom.us and enter the Meeting ID and passcodes to be connected for the duration of the holiday.
