Once again we find ourselves making a transition from the Days Of Awe to the Days of **שמחה**.

In truth the entire **תשרי / אלול** experience revolves around one central theme.

שופר made the following poignant observation. We begin the month of **אלול** with the sound of the **אדם גדול** reminiscent of the summons to **הר סיני** to receive the **תורה** anew with the presenting of the **לוחות שניתנות**.

Prior to **ראש השנה** we begin the recitation of **ארון הקודש** and we open the **סליחות** and pour out our hearts in the presence of the **תורה** as we say **שמע קולנו ספרי תורה**.

During **תפילה** and the **רשות** we intensify our consciousness of the centrality of **תורה** to our lives by opening the **ארון** frequently during the course of our **תפילה**.

On **יום היכוריות** we progress with this idea by actually removing several **ספרי תורה** and bringing them in the midst of the **בית הכנסת** standing at the **בימה** at **יום טוב** concluding the **ארון** with the **כל נdryi** remaining open during the **מעילה**.

With the arrival of **סוכות** we not only bring the **ספר תורה** to the **בימה** we also encircle it once daily as we chant the **סוכנות** armed with the **ארבעת המינים**, the peak of this relationship culminating with the removal of all the **ספרי תורה** and the revolving around the **בימה** seven times on **הושענא רבא**.

The climax of this deep connection to the **תורה הקדשה** finds its expression with the loving embracing of the **תורה** as we dance in joy and ecstasy over our special bond with **הקדוש ברוך הוא** as expressed on **שמחת תורה**.

מצוות lend meaning to and define our entire lives. Without it we are bereft of the life force that our **נשמות** so desperately need to thrive.

I believe that our **קהילה** has mirrored this experience in its unnatural growth these past few months since the inception of our **מקדש**.

There has been such an amazing joining of **כוחות** and **שאיפה** for growth in **רוחניות** that I can think of no better expression than the upcoming **זמן שמחתינו** that can properly give context to what we have been privileged to all be part of.

May the **קב"ה** continue to bestow His kindness on us as we make the beauty and magnificence of **תורה** an integral part of our lives.

I would like to express deepest gratitude to all of you for enhancing my life and I look forward to ever greater accomplishments together with you and your families.


