

!זמן שמחתינו; Season of Joy!

Once again we find ourselves making a transition from the Days Of Awe to the Days of שמחה.

In truth the entire אלול / אלוּל experience revolves around one central theme.

A אדם גדול made the following poignant observation. We begin the month of אלול with the sound of the שופר reminiscent of the summons to משה רבינו to ascend הר סיני to receive the תורה anew with the presenting of the לוחות שניות.

Prior to ראש השנה we begin the recitation of סליחות and we open the ארון הקודש and pour out our hearts in the presence of the תורה ספרי as we say שמע קולנו.

During ראש השנה and the עשרת ימי תשובה we intensify our consciousness of the centrality of תורה to our lives by opening the ארון frequently during the course of our תפילות.

On יום הכיפורים we progress with this idea by actually removing several ספרי תורה and bringing them in the midst of the בית הכנסת standing at the בימה at כל נדרי concluding the יום טוב with the ארון remaining open during the entire נעילה.

With the arrival of סוכות we not only bring the ספר תורה to the בימה we also encircle it once daily as we chant the ספרי armed with the ארבעת המינים, the peak of this relationship culminating with the removal of all the ספרי תורה and the revolving around the בימה seven times on רבא.

The climax of this deep connection to the תורה הקדושה finds its expression with the loving embracing of the תורה as we dance in joy and ecstasy over our special bond with הוא ברוך as expressed on שמחת תורה.

תורה and its מצוות lend meaning to and define our entire lives. Without it we are bereft of the life force that our נשמות so desperately need to thrive.

I believe that our קהילה קדושה has mirrored this experience in its unnatural growth these past few months since the inception of our מעט מעט.

There has been such an amazing joining of כוחות and שאיפה for growth in רוחניות that I can think of no better expression than the upcoming זמן שמחתינו that can properly give context to what we have been privileged to all be part of.

May הקב"ה continue to bestow His kindness on us as we make the beauty and magnificence of His תורה an integral part of our lives.

I would like to express deepest gratitude to all of you for enhancing my life and I look forward to ever greater accomplishments together with you and your families.

Wishing you all נחת; געזונט פרנסה; health, financial security, and yiddishe nachas as we celebrate this wonderful upcoming יום טוב together.
