RABBI'S MESSAGE

Hear, know evil !

Once again the Jewish nation faces the frustrations at attempts to make peace with "בני דודנו"; our "cousins", the בני ישמעאל.

The inequity of their claims coupled with the world's sympathy for their cause add to the feelings of anger that well up within us whenever efforts are made to jeopardize our safety and to compromise once again our inherent right to ירושלים עיר הקודש and ארצנו הקדושה.

At the end of our פרשה the תורה lists the names of the children of ישמעאל. Among the names are "ומשמע ודומה ומשא".

The רמב"ם in a letter (אגרת תימן) in response to the difficulties the Jewish communities were facing with their Arab neighbors tells them that within this פסוק lies the תורה's directive in how to deal with them.

The word משמע means to listen, דומה to be silent and משא to bear. Although we must make השתדלות to physically respond when necessary and appropriate, nevertheless the ultimate response, despite our great frustrations, is to listen and not react while bearing the pain of injustice.

חז"ל teach us that when external battles are fought although we must go through the motions of war it is ultimately the inner battle of the נשמה and its victory that reflects itself in the overpowering of our enemies.

When facing the challenges of relationships and the accompanying נסיונות they bring, perhaps we should implement the רמב"ם's vital advice.

Listen to the other party and don't automatically respond, bear the insults rather than attacking in return. It doesn't always pay to "win". Take the high road in exhibiting the beautiful מדות of our אבות.

We experience true victory when we stifle our reactions in the spirit of the גבורה of יצחק אבינו that will ultimately overcome the external and internal enemy ישמעאל.

May the זכות of our actions protect us and כלל ישראל from all of our enemies.
