RABBI'S MESSAGE

No Text Messages Please!

This week we read about the touching conclusion to the almost tragic episode of יוסף and his brothers, the יוסף.

At the final appeal of יוסף, יוסף, can no longer contain himself, ולא יכל יוסף להתאפק , he breaks down and finally reveals his true identity embracing his brothers lovingly.

What was so moving in the words of יוסף that penetrated the heart of יוסף?

In the previous יוסף when יוסף is brought before יוסף, although יוסף is overwhelmed with emotion nevertheless he succeeds in composing himself ויתאפק, and gains control of himself. What happened now?

Before יהודה begins his entreaty he makes a intriguing request, בי אדני ידבר נא עבדך דבר באזני אדני; please my master allow your servant to speak to the ears of my master. What else does one speak to if not the ears?!

In the previous dialogues a translator transmits the message, not allowing for the speaker to articulate and express its deepest feelings which can only be conveyed in direct communication. רב אברהם בן הרמב"ם writes that speech is not merely a tool that brings a message, it is the method by which the נפש imparts its deepest and sincerest emotions and feelings.

The זוהר describes the mouth in terms of מלכות; royalty, for wielded properly the power of speech can reflect the noblest of our intentions and the majesty of our character.

יהודה the epitome of מלכות understood this well. He realized that direct communication even without an apparent full understanding by the listener of the language spoken, can transmit a message more powerfully than the finest translation. It was this heartfelt plea that found its mark in the heart of יוסף.

We live in an age of the most sophisticated types of communication, yet it seems that the more we advance the more primitive is our ability to transmit our true feelings. In our distancing each other through text and instant messaging, e-mails or voice mail, we not only lose touch with those we speak to but we ultimately lose touch with ourselves!

May we learn the language and power of direct expression and communication, assuring that in the process we will enhance our relationships with our fellow man.
