#### RABBI'S MESSAGE:

As Abraham and Sarah set out for the journey of their lifetime, heading towards the Promised Land, the very first detail Abraham attends to after arriving in the land and building an Altar in tribute to G-d having appeared to him and promising him that He will give this land to his offspring, is to first pitch his wife's tent and then attend to his.

These were their 'Central Headquarters' that drew the masses who sought the truth and whom eventually joined Abraham and Sarah in their life's mission to promote the sovereignty of G-d.

From this inspired abode a world was stirred to a belief in One G-d.

In the ensuing portions this 'tent' is referenced time and again.

We will be introduced to the marvelous tent of Abraham and Sarah, where three angels disguised as wayfarers become beneficiaries of their legendary kindness.

We are taught that in the merit of Abraham having offered them some water his descendants were gifted with the Well of Miriam, that miraculous well which traveled with them during their forty year sojourn in the desert, providing them with refreshing water at all times.

In reward for his providing them food, his children would also be blessed with the amazing Manna that fell daily during their travels, enabling them to experience in it the taste of whatever food they so desired.

The Clouds of Glory that provided protection against the elements and their enemies during their forty year sojourn in the desolate desert was given to them in reciprocation for Abraham having offered his guests some much needed shade.

The illustrious and beloved Rosh HaYeshiva of Yeshivas Mir, Rav Chaim Shmulevitz, of blessed memory, questioned the significance of these acts that warranted such extraordinary gifts.

Don't we all readily offer drink, food and shelter to our guests and even strangers who are in need?

He answered, that it is not the gift of water, food or the providing of a roof over their heads per se that warranted the reward, but rather the manner in which was done.

Abraham threw himself fully into the task at hand. With the same totality that Abraham was willing to forfeit his life for his beliefs when Nimrod threatened to toss him into a fiery furnace unless he submitted to idolatry; he dedicated himself wholly to the performance of kindness. Abraham gave his complete and undivided focus and energy to the persons and their needs.

Our Sages reveal that as long as Sarah lived her tent was blessed with three things:

There was a special blessing in her dough, a candle remained lit from Shabbat to Shabbat, and a cloud hovered above the tent.

She too invested her entire being and essence in assuring that everything she did was done absolutely 100%.

She prepared her food with great attention to every loving detail, insuring that her family and guests would be provided from G-d's bounty appropriately.

# Absolut Shabbat!

The candles with which she illuminated her tent enabled all who entered her home to view each other accurately, looking deeply into one another's eyes, absorbing and conveying the warmth of a smile and the sense of connection evident in the glint of an eye.

The cloud represented an environment that was safely insulated from the cacophony of noise and distraction that accompanies our interactions in the contentious arena called 'life'.

All who entered Sarah's tent found a calm and peaceful haven, allowing them to focus on their relationships and appreciation of their lot, far removed from the invasion of artifice the outside world constantly assaults us with.

On Shabbat we too attempt to recreate this 'Garden of Eden' on earth that is the spiritual legacy of Abraham and Sarah.

We prepare exquisite cuisine in its honor so we may realize and appreciate fully the gifts God has lovingly provided for us and show cognizance and gratitude for His unconditional love.

We spend quality time around the table gazing lovingly at our children, spouses and friends, peering lovingly into their eyes and souls, warmly reasserting that which is so important to us; our relationships.

We put away all our 'toys' of diversion, cell phones, computers, media et al; refrain from 'mundane' chatter; create a protective cloud called Shabbat, that all permits us to enjoy life purely once again.

We can only recreate the tent of Abraham and Sarah if we give of ourselves with absolute attention, devotion and effort.

In proportion to the energies we invest in this weekly project called 'Shabbat' in the spirit of our beloved Patriarchs and Matriarchs, will we merit to reap the rewards of being warmed by our common bond and love and sense the adoring and encouraging embrace of G-d.

May we all merit experiencing an 'Absolut Shabbat'!
