RABBI'S MESSAGE

? מי אני; Who am I ?

אני לדודי ודודי לי; I am to my beloved and my beloved is to me. This most poignant expression symbolizes the essence of the אלוה of עבודה. Our fear and חרדה of the יום הדין stems from an overwhelming sense of love and the special relationship we possess with הקב"ה. Our desire to live up to our own commitment to His unconditional love fills us with a sense of trepidation whether we can indeed fulfill all that we would really want to.

אני לדודי; I am to my beloved... Our pledge of allegiance to our "beloved" begins with אני; I. A person can see himself as an entity that simply begins with his head and ends by his soles, a Jew however defines his, I, with a totally different perception.

אם אין אני לי מי לי וכש אני לעצמי מה אני; Hillel is describing who "I" really am. A person must assume responsibility for own his unique role in this world, but he must realize that if he sees himself as a isolated individual then he has not truly discovered his true self. A person is his wife, his children, his family, his community, his city and ultimately his people. How we utilize our unique gifts, talents and personalities in serving them and Hashems world around us ultimately defines who we truly are.

If "I" am to myself then who am "I"? If there is no אני then there is no לדודי. How I interact with those I am responsible for and involved with, how I serve the needs of the ציבור I am part of, how I contribute to the general welfare of society is inevitably how I dedicate myself to הקב"ה; דודי. [based on the הקדמה of זצ"ל of הגר"ש שקאפ]

The very first step in reestablishing our loving relationship with Hashem begins with the realization that I make a difference in the world and that this affect is contingent on understanding who I really am. The asserting of ones self will find its expression in the manner we relate to others.

The month of אלול must be experienced with a greater sensitivity to the people around us in order for us to merit the חסד of our beloved, Hashem in our impending judgment. May we be זוכה to find ourselves and restore our special relationship with Hashem.
