RABBI'S MESSAGE

Yes We Can, Yes We Will!

When will all the suffering end? Why are we so challenged? The sick and infirm, the victims of terror, the emotionally tormented, the impoverished, the tortured children and parents trying so hard to relate to one another. What does G-d want from us?

The challenges are so enormous we often feel hopeless in our ability to survive them. Why are we being so tested?

The saintly Chofetz Chaim zt"l once summoned the staff of his illustrious Yeshiva on Hoshana Rabba. He turned to them and began speaking of the glorious times that await the Jewish people with the coming of Mashiach. He wondered out loud,"why is it that our nation is so afflicted and facing so many troubles, has Hashem abandoned us?"

He continued,"our Father, in His boundless love for His precious children, realizes that with the advent of the redemption, בחירה; free will, will cease to exist, as it is stated, בחירה; and Hashem, your G-d, will circumcise your heart..., which we are taught to mean that there will no longer be an inclination to sin.
