RABBI'S MESSAGE:

On Purim night we recited after the Megillah how Haman *'would not remember Shaul's compassion, that through his pity on Agag the foe was born.'*

This refers to an episode hundreds of years earlier when Shaul did not fulfill the directive to wipe out every Amalekite, permitting their king to remain alive enabling him to impregnate a woman that very night from whom Haman descended.

At first glance this would be taking Haman to task for not exhibiting gratitude to the Jews who were responsible for his very existence.

Yet, it leaves us wondering that listed among his many failures to act humanely, among them genocide, this lack of a positive attribute of gratitude is even worthy of mention.

Perhaps the message being conveyed is not as much about gratitude as it is about the irony of this fact, that the champion of genocide was a product of a 'coincidental' event carried out by a Jew.

To deny this obvious orchestration of events by the hand of G-d, is indeed the core of the problem with Amalek. When events transpire that can only be described as stranger than fiction and we ignore them, is when we permit our cognitive dissonance to generate the vilest of corrupted attitudes.

The Torah records this week the laws associated with the bringing of a Korban Todah — thanksgiving-offering.

We are all familiar with the notion of the four life-threatening situations that obligate a person to give thanks to Hashem after being saved, as

enumerated in Tehillim. Despite this 'obligation' to thank Hashem, in the days when the Temple stood it was not necessarily categorized as an obligatory sacrifice. One had to formally offer it and declare it as a 'donation'.

The obvious message in this anomaly is that there is no such thing as an 'obligation' to thank. Thanks, must come naturally. Forced thanks is an oxymoron.

But maybe there is a secondary message as well. We never just thank for the life-saving event alone. Even when bringing a Todah one must merely give praise to G-d, there is no obligation to enumerate the details per se. The episode however must compel to see the bigger picture and come to a realization that we must acknowledge how benevolent G-d is in every fiber of our being and the He orchestrates every detail of our lives, from our very existence to every challenge and joy we experience.

May we each implement this idea into our every moment, not simply thanking G-d for saving the Jews in the days of Purim, but to thrill in the knowledge of His devotion to us at any given moment and be inspired by that to prod us to greater gratitude and devotion to Hashem.
