RABBI'S MESSAGE

The Wizard Of "אָא"

At the moment of the splitting of the sea, משה רבינו is overwhelmed with excitement and boundless joy. Seeking to put his heartfelt emotions to words, he begins a "song" with the word "יאז"; then! "אז ישיר משה". The explains that משה intending to rectify a previous misstatement, exclaims: "with "אז" I went afoul when I castigated Hashem when I stated, "און באתי אל פרעה... הרע לעם הזה... he did evil to this people, therefore with "און will heap praise upon Him, "שיר משה... "Then Moshe chose to sing."

One must however travel the cycle of descent and ascent before finally "arriving".

A follower of the saintly דברי חיים sought solace and advice from the Rebbe over some difficulties he was having with a competitor. The Rebbe asked him if he ever observed his horse when he goes to the stream to drink. He pointed out to him that the horse firsts kicks and stirs up the water before he laps it up. This is because when he sees his reflection he thinks it is another horse, his competitor. By agitating the water he makes the other horse disappear!

Every challenge we face is ours to own up to. It is much easier to blame and seek to rid ourselves of the "competition". What we see is none other than ourselves and our unique mission in life and its responsibilities.
