## RABBI'S MESSAGE

# הנה יום הדין!

Harav Dessler זצ"ל would say that if a person wants to comprehend the weightiness and significance of ראש השנה as the יום הדין, one should contemplate all the events of the past year and realize that all that has transpired was determined last ראש השנה. The births and the deaths, the recoveries and the illnesses, the happiness and the sadness, the accomplishments and the disappointments were all results of last year's reckoning.

Perhaps an extra surge of intensity in תפילה last ראש השנה would have determined events differently. Perhaps a greater effort in achieving a תשובה גמורה would have made a world of a difference. Perhaps a additional act of חסד would have tipped the scales in our favor. This single yet powerful message brings to focus the imperative to be ever ready and better prepared for the upcoming יום הדין.

This approach not only must awaken us to the seriousness and reality of ראש השנה, it should also compel us to better appreciate all the good that has come our way this past year. Reflecting on the past and the value of all that is truly important in life allows us to daven with a greater awareness of our tremendous debt of gratitude we owe Hashem for all that He has done for us so benevolently. This asserts our total dependence and complete faith in Him. Isn't this the ultimate goal of ראש השנה? We enthrone the מלך מלכי המלכים and express our absolute belief that He is a מלך רחמן who seeks only our welfare.
