## ***Now Hiring Camp Shelanu Staff!***

Camp Shelanu - Congregation B'nai Israel's summer day camp program - is looking for compassionate, fun, and creative camp staff! If you like to play, sing, create, laugh and interact with campers between 5 and 15 years old, we invite you to be a part of our Camp Shelanu team. It's a great opportunity to work with kids while developing new and effective leadership skills.

Our camp consists of five one-week sessions from July 1<sup>st</sup>-August 2<sup>nd</sup>. There is one week of staff training from June 24<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>, and during the last two days of camp, you are expected to stay until 6:00 pm to help with camp cleanup. **You must be available for the entire timeframe.**

### POSITIONS AVAILABLE:

#### **Senior Camp Counselors - Salary range: \$1500 - \$1700**

Must be at least 18 and have camp experience and/or experience working with kids. Senior counselors are responsible for supervising campers, planning and implementing group activities, leading games, and working directly with their junior counselor and/or counselor-in-training. Working knowledge of Jewish culture strongly preferred. Applicants must be enthusiastic, flexible, and responsible when working with peers, campers, and parents.

#### **Junior Camp Counselors - Salary range: \$1200 - \$1400**

Must currently be in at least 10<sup>th</sup> grade. Experience with camp or working with kids preferred. Junior Counselors are responsible for planning and leading activities, supervising campers, and modeling leadership for counselors-in-training. A working knowledge of Jewish culture and tradition strongly preferred. Applicants must be enthusiastic, flexible, and responsible when working with peers, campers, and parents.

#### **Tayarim Counselors (One week only) - Salary: \$500**

Must be at least 18 and have camp experience and/or experience working with kids. Tayarim counselors are responsible for supervising middle school-age campers, planning and implementing group activities, and attending all field trips, including overnight camping trip. Working knowledge of Jewish culture strongly preferred. Applicants must be enthusiastic, flexible, and responsible when working with peers, campers, and parents.

#### **Child Care Worker - Rate of pay: \$11/hour**

Must be at least 18 and available to work from 7:30 – 9am and/or from 4 – 6pm, Monday – Friday. Should have experience and ability to plan and lead age-appropriate child care activities.

#### **Lifeguard - Rate of Pay: Dependent on experience and time commitment**

Must have lifeguard certification and CPR training. Responsibilities include overseeing the onsite pools twice a week while the campers swim, and basic maintenance of the pools throughout the summer. Applicants must have good attention to detail and focus. (Lifeguard could also do before and/or after care)

#### **Program Specialists - Rate of Pay: Dependent on experience and time commitment**

Cooking specialist (Three days a week): Responsibilities include planning and leading cooking with campers, preparing challah dough every Friday, and purchasing supplies for all cooking activities and daily snack.

Sports specialists (Two days a week): Responsibilities include planning and leading sports activities with campers twice a week.
