

HIGH HOLY DAYS - ESPECIALLY FOR CHILDREN AT CBI

Family Services

Our High Holy Days Family Services will take place on Rosh Hashanah morning, Monday, September 10, and on Yom Kippur morning, Wednesday, September 19. Both services are at 9:00 am in the Sanctuary for about 30-40 minutes, and are appropriate for families with infants through 3rd grade. **At the Rosh Hashanah Family Service, Rabbi Alfi will be giving a special blessing for all babies born since last Rosh Hashanah,** and the Yom Kippur Family Service will feature a mini Shofar service.

Children's High Holy Days Programs

Please register by Sept. 1 to avoid fee increase.

For Erev Rosh Hashanah, Sunday, September 9, and Kol Nidre, Tuesday, September 18: Childcare begins at 7:30 pm and concludes when the adult services are over. **Childcare is for all children ages 3 to 10.** (No evening children's educational programming will be provided.) The children will be brought to the *bimah* at the beginning of the service on Erev Rosh Hashanah to hear the Shofar blown.

For Rosh Hashanah, Monday, September 10, and Yom Kippur, Wednesday, September 19:

- **For children ages 3-10,** "Apples & Honey" is our educational program that includes crafts, games, Jewish learning, and snacks.
- **For children under the age of 3, registration for childcare is required in advance** on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur morning. Those who have children in diapers or who need bottles must provide a diaper bag clearly labeled with necessary supplies.
- **Parents are requested to pack a sack lunch.** Nothing that needs refrigeration or heating.

Apples & Honey Program Costs

The cost is \$15 per child, per session, for registration with payment received by September 1, and then the price increases to \$18.
