## *Yom Kippur Morning Service*

**Aliyah #1:** Everyone who became a Bar or Bat Mitzvah at B'nai Israel, or was Confirmed at B'nai Israel, is invited to join Rabbi Alfi on the Bimah and recite the blessing together.

**Aliyah #2:** Everyone who was married by a B'nai Israel Rabbi or Cantor is invited to join Rabbi Alfi on the Bimah and recite the blessing together.

**Aliyah #3:** All families who currently have three generations of their family as members of B'nai Israel are invited to join Rabbi Alfi on the Bimah and recite the blessing together.

**Aliyah #4:** Everyone whose family has been members of B'nai Israel for more than 70 years (since 1949 or before) is invited to join Rabbi Alfi on the Bimah and recite the blessing together.

## *Yom Kippur Afternoon Service*

**Aliyah #4:** Everyone who volunteered for Happy Hour Havdalah, Down and Derby, Sukkot Festival, Simchat Torah, Rabbi Alfi's 50th Birthday Celebration, or the Purimspiel, Purim Service, or Carnival is invited to join Rabbi Alfi on the Bimah and recite the blessing together.
