ATTENTION ALL CAMPERS! PRICE CAMBERSHIP AWARD APPLICATION 2021

Are you in 4th, 5th, 6th or 7th grade and planning to attend Camp Newman or another **Union of Reform Judaism (URJ) overnight camp** during the summer of 2021? If your answer is an enthusiastic "YES!" and you didn't receive a campership award for 2020 from the Women of B'nai Israel Price Campership Fund, then you are eligible for some financial help from your Women of B'nai Israel friends.

This award is based on two considerations. The first is your written essay, which is discussed in the next paragraph. The second is what your teachers and the Director of Education tell us about your participation in your Judaic Studies and Hebrew School classes.

Please fill out the application form below. On a separate sheet of paper, please write an essay describing each of the following:

1. Your participation in your Judaic Studies and Hebrew school classes;
2. Your involvement in, and your service to, your Jewish community;
3. How attending a URJ overnight camp will positively impact your participation in your religious school classes and your involvement in your Jewish community; and
4. Why you think it is important to attend a URJ overnight camp.

Include your essay (1 page maximum, handwritten preferred but not required) with the application form. **Please turn in your completed application with your essay no later than February 14, 2021.**

You may turn in the application and essay in one of two ways. First, you may email it directly to Carol Goodman-Gane at cagoodman@sbcglobal.net. If you do this, she will send you an email letting you know she has it. Second, you may submit it on paper (hard copy) and mail it to:

If you do this, please make a copy for yourself before mailing, and email Carol at cagoodman@sbcglobal.net and let her know when you've mailed it. As soon as Carol receives it, she will send you an email letting you know she has it.

Please note! If URJ camp is open to in-person campers (the current URJ plan) but a student who receives a campership chooses not to attend in person, the campership is deemed revoked and that student will have to reapply for the summer of 2022. In other words, the Women of B'nai Israel will not hold the campership over for another year, unless the camps are closed to in-person attendance as they were in 2020. If it turns out that camp is completely virtual again in 2021, we will hold the funds and allow the awardee to use those funds for in-person camp in 2022.
