## High Holiday Experiences 2021

This year Temple Beth Emet will be offering Hybrid High Holiday Services (virtual and in-person). All members must choose if they would like to attend services in-person or virtually. To make your High Holiday service selection, please fill out the form at [www.templebethemet.org/form/Hybridchoice](http://www.templebethemet.org/form/Hybridchoice). Your choice will help us plan for security and allow us to have protocols in place to keep everyone safe.

Please note we will not have childcare available or Aliyahs. For those guests who will be attending in person, we will be asking you to social distance and wear masks in public areas such as the lobby and bathrooms. Masks are preferred during sanctuary/social hall seating.

High Holidays tickets are \$186 for members wanting to purchase additional tickets and \$250 for each non-member ticket. *These prices are for both virtual and in-person options.*

For guests who will be virtual and would like prayer books you can:

1. PURCHASE - for \$50, one set of (2) High Holiday books from the Temple (one holiday \$25).
2. RENT - for a \$50 deposit, one set of (2) High Holiday prayer books (\$25 deposit for one holiday only). Once you return the books you will receive a \$30 refund (\$10 refund for one book).

### L'dor V'dor, From Generation to Generation

I often ponder, what really connects me to Temple Beth Emet? Sure my kids attended the Early Childhood Center, Camp Beth Emet, Religious school, and had their B'nai Mitzvahs at TBE, but those are in the past.

So, what is it that really keeps me involved and makes TBE an important aspect of my life? I never thought I would find my answer in a social media post, but that's exactly what happened. With permission I share the post of Brina (Chajet) Goulder:

*"Yesterday I sat in a carpool line for the very first time on the "other side". To drop off and pick up my first baby on his very first day of a school setting. He was beyond ready and his confidence and excitement leading up was contagious. I kept waiting for the wave of anxiety about my "baby" being away from me to kick in, but as I watched him walk away with a counselor I was met by one of the most surreal feelings I've ever experienced. Years ago that counselor was me taking someone else's baby out of the car and walking them into their classroom. The same line, at the same school, with the same teachers. My heart swelled when the full weight of life coming full circle sank in. I've been at Beth Emet since I was 6 years old. Hebrew school, camp, youth group, then working camp and aftercare at the day school. I grew up in those classrooms making friendships and memories that I still carry with me. It saw all of the ups, downs of my growing up - the good along with the inevitable teenage immaturity, drama, and questionable decision making. (Fun Fact - I once ran away...to temple) It has always been what felt safe, familiar, and like a second home. Watching Emmett walk into camp yesterday it hit me that this was the start of Beth Emet being his home too. The place where he'd grow up building his own relationships, memories, and life experiences. A place where he'll feel safe as he grows to not only have fun, but to make those important mistakes, learn from them and grow into the person he is meant to become. There is no place I trust more to give that to him than Beth Emet. After all, that's what it gave me. Because of that there wasn't an anxious thought in my brain (for maybe the first time ever). My heart is full knowing what this place gave and continues to give me, and what it will give my babies. I want to sit in this feeling forever because it truly is one of the most extraordinary things I've ever experienced."*

If I didn't already have a tear in my eye from reading Brina's post, my 19 year old daughter's reply, "That baby was me you took out of the car!" for sure got me all choked up.

I found my answer; it was always there, but I just needed the realization. "L'dor V'dor, from generation to generation, is why Temple Beth Emet is so important to me and to the Jewish community. Put simply, L'dor vador refers to continuity, to the responsibility of passing on spiritual knowledge and cultural traditions from generation to generation for the purpose of sustaining the customs, heritage, and collective memory of the Jewish people. I realized how much this meant to me - how special this connection and this community is to me and to my children.

I'd imagine many of you have similar connections, and maybe you already have identified those. For those of you who haven't, take a few minutes, give it some soul searching & I suspect it will become more apparent to you.

Through my years of volunteering, annual financial commitments and my "Legacy Gift," my family & I stay involved ensuring Temple Beth Emet will be here for future generations. 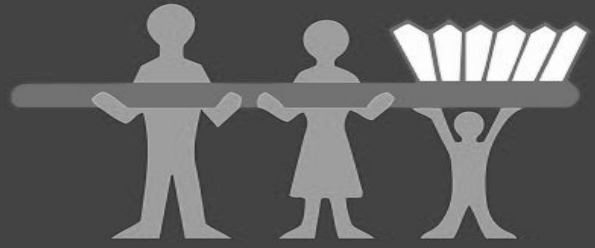

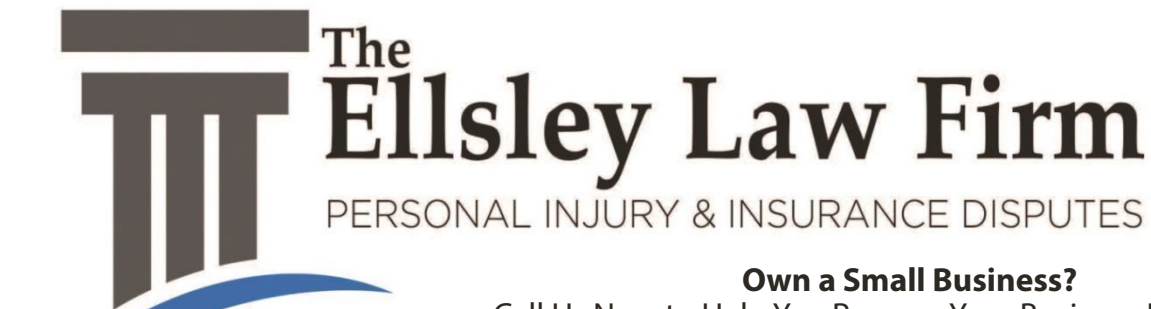
