Since I was 10 years old, becoming the President of my temple has been a goal of mine. I remember sitting in High Holy Day services listening to my uncle give the Yom Kippur appeal and thinking that someday I would love the same chance to serve my congregation and to make a difference. Being named

I grew up in the suburbs of Philly, attending a conservative temple: Har Zion. As a child, I was very busy playing sports and didn't really pay much attention to being Jewish. But after experiencing anti-Semitism at my small liberal arts college in Ohio and then going to Israel through the birthright program while in graduate school at UM, everything changed for me. When I came back to the states, I started going to Shabbat services, began keeping kosher (to an extent) and I became the President of the Graduate Student Association of Hillel at Miami. After graduate school I moved to Broward County, joined a conservative synagogue in Weston and soon after met my wife, Aimee. Many of you may know her since she began working for TBE's Early Childhood Center in December of 2010.

We moved away for my career for a short period of time to Orlando, then Cherry Hill, NJ and then returned to Florida in the fall of 2015. When we came back it was clear Temple Beth Emet was our home. Aimee was able to come back to the Early Childhood Center where she has been the program coordinator for both the school and Camp Beth Emet for almost eight years. Both of our children, Eliot and Ava, are graduates of the ECC and have had many wonderful summers at the camp. Eliot had his Bar Mitzvah in March of 2020 and is now a part of Jewish Teen Leadership, as well as the Youth Group. Ava is currently in Merkaz Limud and will celebrate her Bat Mitzvah in February 2025.

A few of my goals as President are:

- 1. to learn from and work with our Clergy and Board as we look towards the future of Temple Beth Emet,
- 2. to be visible at Temple and School events,
- 3. to engage and foster relationships with our current and future congregants and
- 4. to provide support for TBE's Capital Fundraising Campaign.

I look forward to serving our Temple Beth Emet community.

Leila Siegel






