




## Rabbi's Ramblings

It's summertime. Florida summertime is hot. Florida summertime is hot and humid. Florida summertime is hot, humid and rainy. You get the picture. The song says, "Summertime and the 'livin' is easy." Summertime and traditionally synagogue activities grind to a halt. Here, at TBE we will be packed with action as five hundred or so kids enjoy summer camp. Services will continue both in person (we want you back and we want to see your faces and shake your hands) and on Zoom, Facebook and [www.templebethemet.org](http://www.templebethemet.org). A group will be traveling to Israel and plans will be made for next year's programming.

Yes, it is hot. But it is also a great time to practice some spiritual actions. For instance, instead of walking out your door and complaining about the heat, give thanks that you don't have to shovel your driveway. But seriously, instead of complaining about the heat spend a moment feeling the air and the humidity and just try to enjoy it for a few minutes.

When you are out walking to your car, look up or down and admire a flowering tree or shrub. Don't rush by it, stop and look at the shape of the petals and leaves, look for the insects that may be feeding on it, remember that even if they are pests they are an important part of the ecosystem. If they weren't they would not have been created.

This summer make a commitment that for one meal there will be no cell phones and that you will experience the mindfulness of eating, that you will talk to another with your full attention with no distractions.

This summer make a decision to practice two things that we often ask you to do at services:

1. Remember to give thanks for your blessings and for the people in your lives.
2. Remember to call those special people and tell them how you feel.
3. Practice a loving-kindness meditation: May I be blessed; May I be filled with loving-kindness; May I have peace.
4. After you have blessed yourself, bless someone else: May x be blessed, etc.

May you have a peaceful and relaxing summer filled with blessings.

I recently flew on an airplane to visit family. I drew some fascinating realizations about the trip, especially regarding the airplane. On some level, it was a shared experience with over one hundred other fliers. We boarded in the same location. We heard the same directions from the flight attendants. Everyone on board was offered food and drink. We exited in the same place. On a different level, the experience was all mine as an individual. I played games with my family. I was annoyed and frustrated by the group in front of me with a child who was misbehaving, or maybe it was the parents who did not have patience for the kid. I read and watched videos on my own. My drink order was not necessarily the same as others. I sat closer to the back of the plane while others were closer to the front. I had both a shared experience and a unique experience at the same time.

This happens throughout life. Have you ever attended a concert or a sporting event? While we live our lives alongside millions of other people where others are sharing similar moments, we often think of ourselves as the center of the universe, living a unique life.

Our tradition teaches that each person is created with a unique purpose in life and that is what drives us to be our own selves searching for and accomplishing whatever that purpose is. While we have our own specific purpose, we continue to have collective life moments. We also are taught that every Jewish soul, past, present and future were present at Mt. Sinai to hear the revelation of Torah. By everyone having this collective experience, we are reminded about the equality we have amongst every other human being.

At Shabbat services at Temple Beth Emet, some people come in person to pray, some come for the oneg dessert, some join us virtually. We all pray as one community having the shared power of prayer while we each pray as individuals, fulfilling a need for peace, reflection and being present in the moment. We have both a communal experience and a unique experience at the same time.

How can we be successful at living both simultaneously? The ultimate answer lies in finding balance and recognizing it is ok to have the two components, the individual and communal, with each one being important.

Tradition teaches that we are supposed to carry two notes in our pockets. One note reads that we were created from dust and ash, keeping us humble when we become too full of ourselves. The other reads that the world was created for me, lifting one up when feeling truly down. The notes remind us of balance. May we each find an equilibrium as we live life as one people and as individuals.

On Earth Day 2023, the campus shared by the Beth Emet Early Childhood Center and K-8 School proudly announced that they have achieved the Florida Green Schools' Green Apple designation from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. This designation comes as a combined effort by the members of Temple Beth Emet's "Tevah (Green) Team," led by Leah Perl, who is also a Beth Emet ECC parent!

The Florida Green School designation program recognizes schools that commit to conserving and protecting the state's natural resources. To become designated, schools must evaluate their operations, set goals and act to continuously improve environmental performance in five areas of operation: communication and education; waste reduction, reuse and recycling; water conservation; energy efficiency; and air quality.

With the Green Apple designation, Temple Beth Emet becomes the first Jewish Green School in Florida! We'd like to thank the Tevah Team, and our community of families, staff, and the children of Beth Emet Schools for this achievement!

Jakob perished in the Holocaust in Poland at 12 years old in 1939. Jakob never had the opportunity to become a bar mitzvah, so Blake wants to keep his legacy alive. This was made possible through the amazing nonprofit, Remember Us -The Holocaust B'nai Mitzvah Project.

Blake would like to thank Debra Dayan, Rabbi Greenspon, Rabbi DeWoskin, Cantor Jan and all the teachers at TBE ECC and Merkaz Limud for their mentorship, patience, and support in preparing him for this special milestone.
