## *Rabbinically Yours* By Rabbi Earl Kideckel



### Sukkot, you are invited!

All of summer I have been marveling at the colors of the many flowers in our flower beds and pots. It seems as though it was just yesterday that Lisa and I had gone to the local nursery to find the precise flowers that she wanted. And now as I peer out my window, I see the change of seasons in front of me. Soon it will be fall, and the colors we'll be experiencing will come from the natural colors of the trees changing colors and shedding their leaves.

With the change of colors from flowers to falling leaves, we celebrate the arrival of fall with Jewish celebrations of the end of the harvest season with the festivals of Sukkot and Shemini Atzeret/Yizkor. From my childhood days, I remember the elaborate decorations, gourds, fruits and other hanging ornaments that hung in our shul's sukkah. When I went to JTS, I looked forward to the fully catered dinners that took place in the Sukkah on the first and second nights of the festival. Needless to say, it took volunteers and custodial staff countless days and hours to put the magnificent touches that made the Seminary Sukkah the talk of Manhattan.

For the past thirty-nine years, I have enjoyed putting up a Sukkah in our own yard and benching *etrog* and *lulav* there.

This year, Lisa and I, together with the programming committee, are inviting you to join us as we usher in Sukkot on Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup>. Last year, we enjoyed the more than 60 people who joined with us outside in our Sukkah and on our lawn. Please RSVP to the office so that the programming committee can prepare enough pizza and drinks for us all. As the evening comes in, we will join for *kiddush*, welcoming in the *chag*. On Monday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, we will once again join together at Temple Israel, Park St, at 10 a.m. for Sukkot services where you will have the opportunity to bench *etrog* and *lulav*. And then on Sunday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, we will join at Congregation B'nai Israel in Willimantic with the other shuls of our area to celebrate Simchat Torah. We are offering everyone the opportunity this year to read a word from the end of the Book *Devarim* (Deuteronomy) or from the beginning of the Book of *Bereishit* (Genesis). No Hebrew reading knowledge is necessary, but an RSVP for Pizza and reading of a letter is greatly appreciated. Then, again on the morning of Monday October 17<sup>th</sup>, we will once again join together to celebrate Shemini Atzeret, Simchat Torah and to recite Yizkor at Temple Israel on Park St. in New London.

Finally a special *todah rabbah* to Judy Engel, Ed Goldberg, Kathleen McFadden, Ira Cohen, the High Holy Day Honors Committee, all of the volunteers, our office professionals, Cantor Paul Dorman, those who provided home hospitality to Cantor Dorman, Marcia Reinhard, and Dona Casey, who worked diligently to make the High Holy Days meaningful and successful.

**Meet the Author:** Rebecca Frankel is the author of New York Times best-selling WAR DOGS: Tales of Canine Heroism, History, and Love and INTO THE FOREST: A Holocaust Story of Survival, Triumph, and Love which was named one of "The Ten Best History Books of 2021" by Smithsonian magazine, and a 2021 National Jewish Book Award finalist.

Frankel is a longtime editor and journalist and was formerly executive editor of Foreign Policy's print magazine, and managing editor of Moment magazine. She has been a guest on Conan, PBS News-Hour, BBC World News, and the Diane Rehm Show, among others. Her written work has appeared in The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, National Geographic, The Washington Post, and elsewhere.

In the summer of 1942, the Rabinowitz family narrowly escaped the Nazi ghetto in their Polish town by fleeing to the forbidding Bialowieza Forest. They miraculously survived two years in the woods—through brutal winters, Typhus outbreaks, and merciless Nazi raids—until they were liberated by the Red Army in 1944. After the war they trekked across the Alps into Italy where they settled as refugees before eventually immigrating to the United States.

During the first ghetto massacre, Miriam Rabinowitz rescued a young boy named Philip by pretending he was her son. Nearly a decade later, a chance encounter at a wedding in Brooklyn would lead Philip to find the woman who saved him, and to discover her daughter Ruth was the love of his life. (He is Rabbi Philip Lazowski, Rabbi Emeritus of Emanuel Synagogue, West Hartford.)

From a little-known chapter of Holocaust history, one family's inspiring true story.
