

# High Holy Day Mahzor Loan Program



We look forward to celebrating the High Holy Days with you in a few weeks. With our virtual services, the synagogue will be lending the *Mahzor Lev Shalem* to our members for the High Holy Days. We want to thank the Berger family for their generous gift in purchasing the Mahzorim and allowing the synagogue to lend these books to our members this year.

Individual members will receive one Mahzor; couples and families will receive two prayer books. If you need additional prayer books, please call the synagogue office to let us know that additional ones are needed and specify how many.

The Mahzorim will be part of a High Holy Days bag, which will include other useful information. If you already have the *Mahzor Lev Shalem*, we still welcome you to pick up this bag. For members who already have prayer books, we want to make sure that you receive all High Holy Day information; please call the office if you do not plan to pick up the bag so we can send you this information.

The books will be available for pickup at the synagogue during specific times, and we will deliver the books to those unable to pick them up here. All books are numbered so we know who has received books, and this will allow us to track the return of these books after the High Holy Days.

Please note the pick-up schedule for September 8 through September 13:

Tuesday, September 8	Noon – 2 PM, members with last names A-L
Tuesday, September 8	4 PM – 6 PM, members with last names M-Z
Wednesday, September 9	10 AM – Noon, members with last names M-Z
Wednesday, September 9	6 PM – 8 PM, members with last names A-L
Thursday, September 10	10 AM – Noon, all members may pick up
Thursday, September 10	6 PM – 8 PM, all members may pick up
Sunday, September 13	10 AM – Noon, all members may pick up
Sunday, September 13	5 PM - 6 PM, All members may pick up

- If you know which date you will be picking up books, please let the office know. This is not required, but will help staff prepare for each pickup session.
- If you need your books delivered to you, please call the office to let us know. We expect to start delivering books the week of September 6.
- If none of the above times work for you, please email or call the office and we will arrange a time for you to pick up your books.
- If you already have the *Mahzor Lev Shalem* and are not picking up a bag, please make sure we know so that all High Holy Day information is sent to you.
- Books will not be mailed to local or out of town members.
- Books will not be distributed to non-members.
- Following the High Holy Days, we will arrange return times for easy drop off.
- If books are not returned to the synagogue, the synagogue reserves the right to charge members \$36 for each book.

Thank you for your cooperation, and we look forward to celebrating the High Holy Days virtually with all of you.
