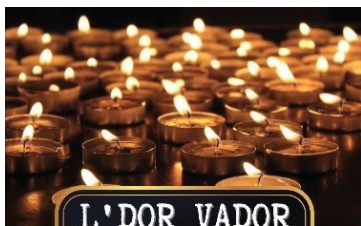

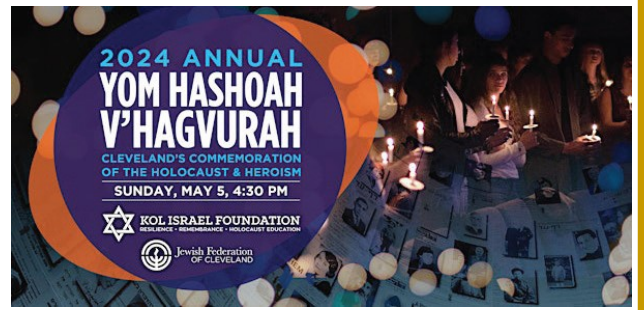
This year's theme is *L'dor V'dor* (from Generation to Generation). We
