

For his Mitzvah Project, Ari is raising money to help support Herps Alive, a non-profit reptile rescue organization.





### **Memorial Scrolls Trust**

Sunday, April 23 • 1 pm • The Temple Tifereth Israel



Join in for this meaningful gathering and joyful reunion of the scrolls in Ohio which includes BJC's Holocaust scroll from Ledec. In 1942, Dr. Stein of the *Jüdische Kultusgemeinde* reached out to the over 350 synagogues in Bohemia and Moravia, instructing them to send their *Sefrei Torot* to Prague. Over 1,800 scrolls were sent where they were warehoused and in 1963 brought to London to be restored, forming the Czech Scroll Memorial Trust (MST). In honor of the 80th anniversary of their collection, The Temple Tifereth Israel invites the community (and our MST scroll) to join with them in celebration. Each scroll will be called to the bimah by its community name, and a representative from each organization will read one line of Torah at this Torah Service in memory of the Jews from Czechoslovakia who perished, and in honor of those who survived. **If you would like to attend and be part of BJC's contingent, please contact Jay Ross.**


## Shir Shabbat Service
