Sunday, April 23 • 1 pm • The Temple Tifereth Israel

Join in for this meaningful gathering and joyful reunion of the scrolls in Ohio which includes BJC's Holocaust scroll from Ledec. In 1942, Dr. Stein of the *Jüdische Kiltusgemeinde* reached out to the over 350 synagogues in Bohemia and Moravia, instructing them to send their *Sefrei Torot* to Prague. Over 1,800 scrolls were sent where they were warehoused and in 1963 brought to London to be restored, forming the Czech Scroll Memorial Trust (MST). In honor of the 80th anniversary of their collection, The Temple (Tifereth Israel invites the community (and our MST scroll) to join with
