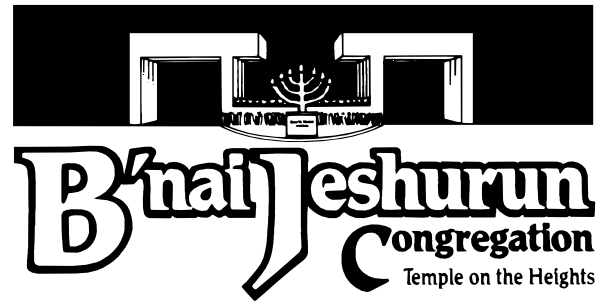

Since May 2018, **Rabbi Ellen S. Wolintz-Fields** proudly serves as the first rabbi in the position of Executive Director of Women's League for Conservative Judaism, a role she dreamt of holding - the ability to spearhead the organization which for over 100 years has been engaging, enriching and empowering Conservative Jewish woman. Previously Rabbi Wolintz-Fields was the Vice-President for Congregational Engagement at ITC, Israel Tour Connection, and for eighteen years, served as a congregational rabbi and educational director in Toms River, NJ, Grayslake, IL and Long Grove, IL. Born in Brooklyn, she graduated from the Double Degree Program at

Barnard College and List College, and majored in Religion and Talmud. She studied for nine years at the Jewish Theological Seminary, where in addition to her BA in Talmud, she earned an MA in Jewish Women's Studies and Rabbinic Ordination.

Rabbi Wolintz-Fields has served as the co-chair of the Rabbinical Assembly's Women's Committee and serves on the RA Executive Council, Resolutions Committee, and the Committee on Jewish Law and Standards. Rabbi Wolintz-Fields is one of the Women's League representatives to the Conference of Presidents of Major American Organizations.

She has been invited to deliver Opening Prayers at the United States House of Representatives, the New Jersey Senate, the New Egypt Speedway, and the Ocean County College Commencement. She is one of the featured Rabbis on the cover of the book "When Rabbis Bless Congress."

Together with her husband Jonathan, they are the proud parents of three children, and live in Ocean Township, New Jersey.

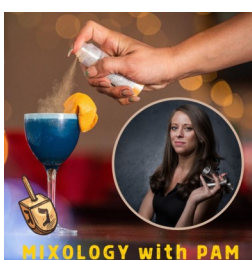

The minyan will always have a minimum of ten participating by stream. Rabbi Weiss has ruled, based on rabbinic and *halakhic* sources, that – on a temporary, emergency basis, and not as a permanent change – a minyan may be comprised of ten Jews at different locations linked over the internet. Therefore, the services will still include those parts that require a minyan and will fulfill that obligation. This includes the mourner's kaddish.
