Tuesday, January 31 • noon

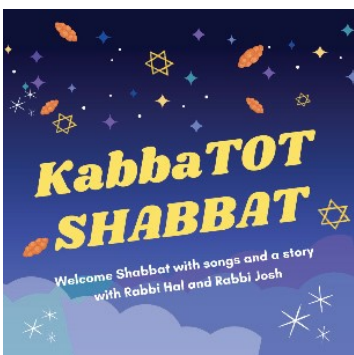
