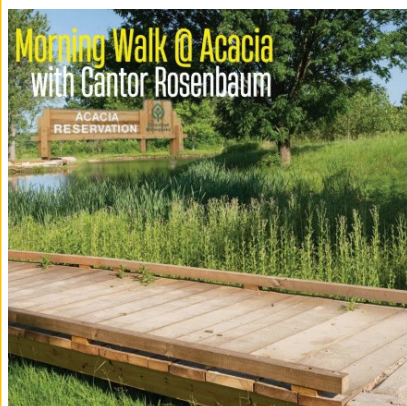
Get the Scoop with Cantor Wednesday, August 10 • 7 - 9 pm
