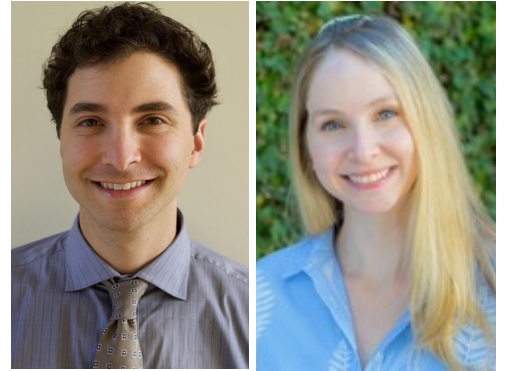

Meet & Greet at Mitchell's

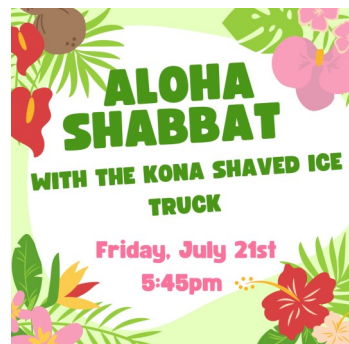

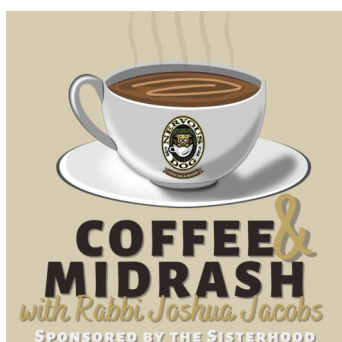

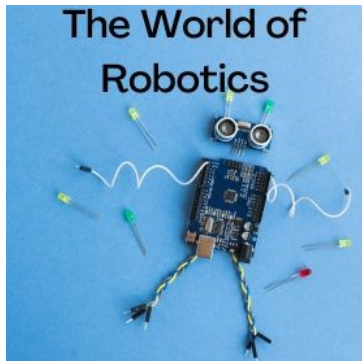


Hike with BJC
