


Guest Speaker Oren Hefetz JNF's Israel Emissary Shabbat, March 18 • 9 am at Services



Firstborns, normally required to fast the day before Pesach, are relieved of this requirement by attending a Torah study session (siyyum) on the morning before the holiday. This year's siyyum will be held on Wednesday, April 5, at the conclusion of the Shaharit service. Minyan will begin at 7:15 am.
