We will come together to celebrate Shabbat each month with tefillah, art and activities. This month, we will explore the Parsha of the week, Lech Lecha.

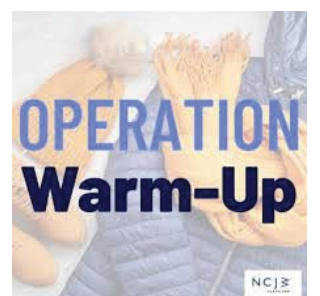
11:30 am - Torah Yoga for congregants of all ages:

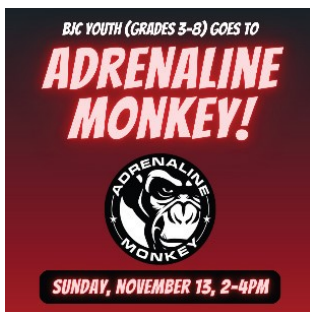
