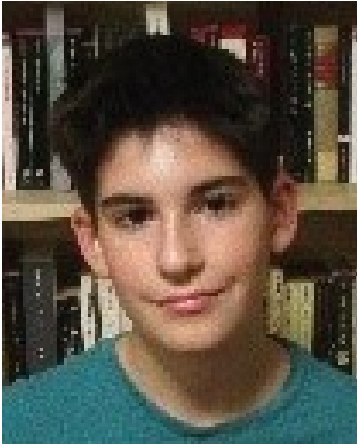

He received PhD from Cambridge, and has held fellowships at Harvard, Princeton, and Oxford. Dr. Porwancher currently serves as the Wick Cary Professor at the University of Oklahoma.

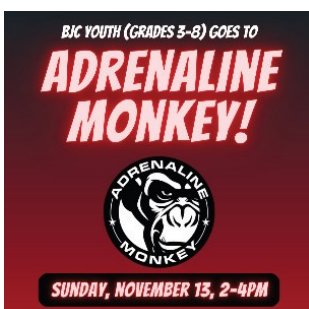
