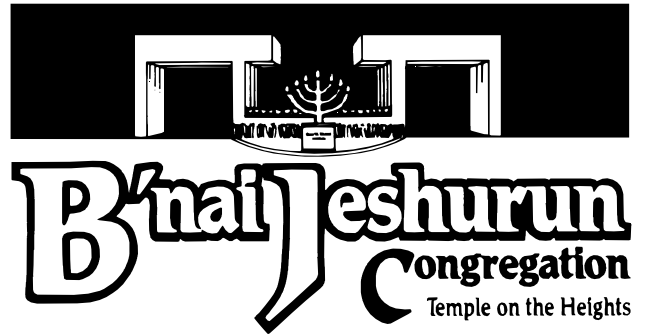

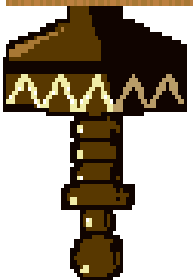

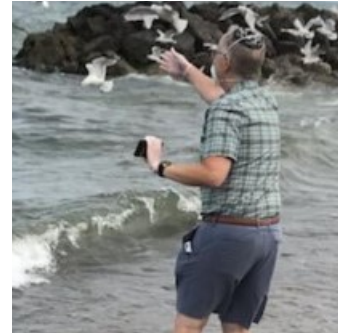

### In-Person Outdoor Tents Services

If you plan to pray in-person outdoors in our tents, you **MUST** provide proof of vaccination (if eligible for the vaccine). If you did not submit a copy to the synagogue office, make sure to bring your card with you to services. Everyone must wear a mask. Please also remember to bring your parking pass and ticket. You will not be permitted onto synagogue property without the parking pass; it is an important part of our security protocol.

Rabbi Weiss has ruled, based on rabbinic and *halakhic* sources, that – on a temporary, emergency basis, and not as a permanent change – a minyan may be comprised of ten Jews at different locations linked over the internet. Therefore, the services will still include those parts that require a minyan and will fulfill that obligation. This includes the mourner's kaddish.
